

## BIBLIOGRAPHY

Modern works are referenced by author and date according to the Harvard notation. For ancient texts contributors have followed various systems: some have followed the Harvard notation throughout and others have employed the forms normally used in the particular specialist fields. In general Assyriological texts are referred to using a system similar to that advocated by the *Chicago Assyrian Dictionary* and Classical texts following the model of the *Oxford Classical Dictionary*, third edition (1996). The editors have attempted to make the references within each article consistent, but have accepted the preferences of the contributors in the way that they have referred to ancient texts.
