This paper, as stated on p. 213, was intended as a preliminary general report. J.E. Reade vastly expanded the information contained in his discussion of the Kuyunjik archives in *Reallexikon der Assyriologie* 9/7-8, 2001, 421-427 which itself is further expanded in Reade's summary and provisional catalogue of the Ishtar Temple archive in *Iraq* 67 (2005) 382.




Fig. 1. Kuyunjik about 640 bc. Author's drawing.

The plan of Kuyunjik in fig. 1 on p. 215 is to be replaced by the updated version published by J.E. Reade in *Iraq* 67 (2005) 348, fig. 1, which is reproduced here with the author's kind permission:

- p. 217 fig. 2: DT 273 has since been joined with another fragment, K 11055.
- p. 218: The structure referred to as Sennacherib's *bit nakkapti* has since been recognized as a gate.
- p. 219 fig. 3: K 3353+ has since been joined with another fragment, K 2158.
